APPLYING FOR A WYOMING CONCEALED WEAPON PERMIT

Park County Sheriff's Office does not issue the permits, but you must apply at the Sheriff's Office of the county you live in. <u>APPLICANTS MUST BE A RESIDENT OF WYOMING FOR AT LEAST SIX (6) MONTHS, OR</u> <u>POSSESS A VALID PERMIT FROM A RECIPROCAL STATE PRIOR TO APPLICATION</u>

**You will need to be fingerprinted for a NEW concealed weapon permit ONLY.

What you will need for NEW APPLICATIONS

- 1. Original notarized application
- 2. Proof of firearms training, safety or proficiency
 Examples: *DD Form 214 *Hunter Safety Card *NRA certified course Certificate
- 3. Driver's license
- 4. Money order or Cashier's check to DCI for \$64.00
- 5. \$15 cash (exact change) for background check
- 6. \$5 cash (exact change) for fingerprints
- 7. \$2 cash for notary (if necessary)

<u>PLEASE CALL THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AFTER 0800 ON THE DAY YOU WISH TO</u> TURN IN YOUR NEW APPLICATION TO SET UP FINGERPRINT APPOINTMENT

What you will need for RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

- 1. Original notarized application
- 2. Money order or Cashier's Check to DCI for \$45 (\$55 if expired less than 6 months)
- 3. 2 \$5 bills for background check
- 4. Driver's License for identification
- 5. 2 dollars cash for notary (if necessary)

-DO NOT SIGN THE BOTTOM OF THE APPLICATION UNLESS YOU SIGN IT IN FRONT OF A NOTARY. (**There is a notary available at the Sheriff's Office.)

**We accept applications Monday through Friday between 0900 and 1100 and 1300 and 1600, but do not recommend turning in your applications on Tuesday because the driver's license office is closed on Tuesdays (applicants will go there to get a picture AFTER application is processed at the Sheriff's Office).

-Plan on spending at least a half-hour at the Sheriff's Office getting all your paper work in order.
